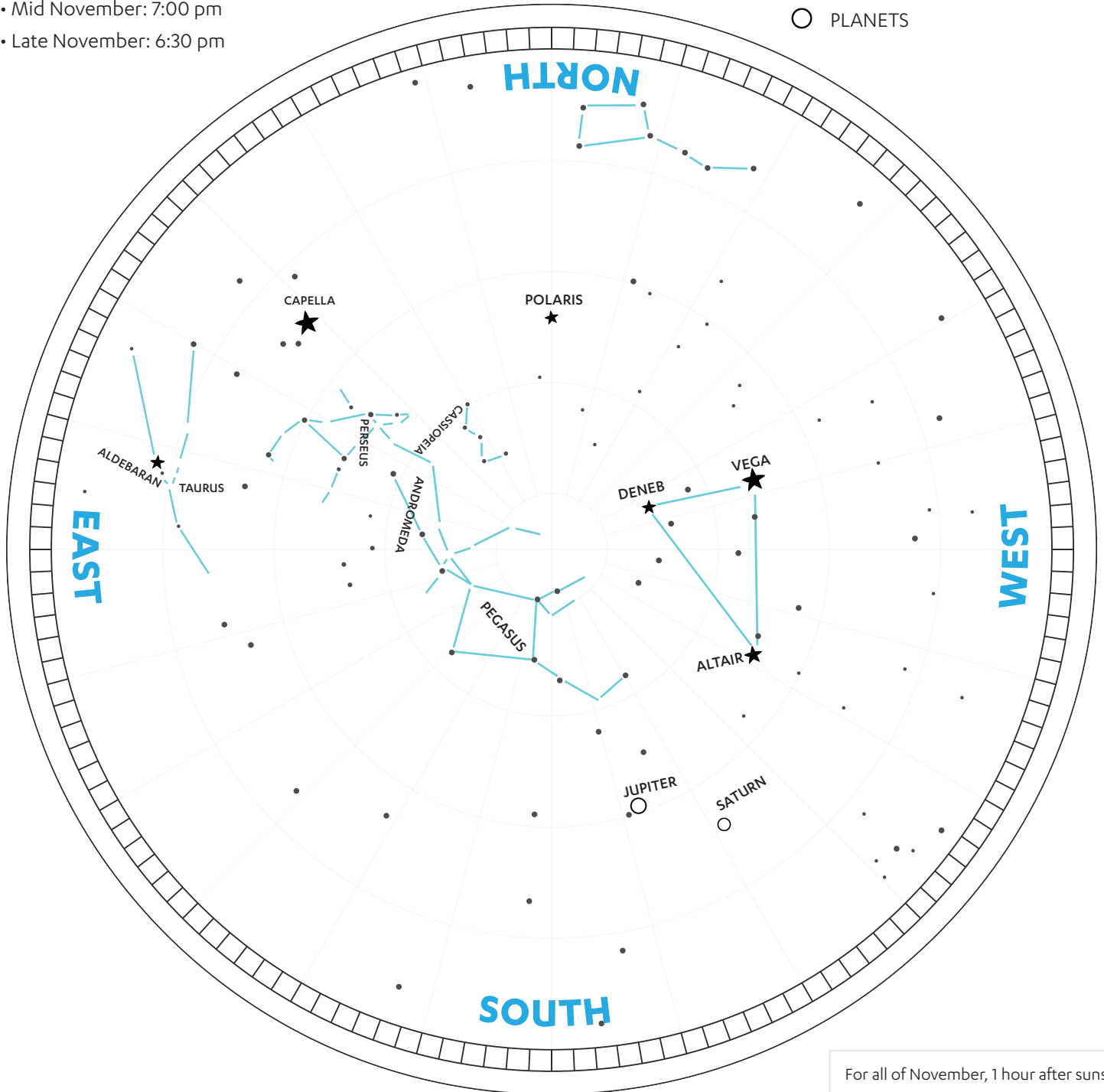


NOVEMBER EVENING SKY MAP

This map represents the sky around these times:

- Early November: 9:00 pm (8:00 pm after DST)
- Mid November: 7:00 pm
- Late November: 6:30 pm

- ★ BRIGHTEST STARS
- CONSTELLATIONS & ASTERISMS
- PLANETS



HOW TO USE STAR MAP:

1. Face north and hold the sky map with north at the bottom.
2. Locate bright stars, constellations & asterisms in this part of the sky.
3. Choose another direction and repeat for each direction!

This map is drawn for New Jersey skies, but will be useful anywhere in the continental United States.

For all of November, 1 hour after sunset, Venus will be visible in the southwest sky.
